

Procedure to fill wool


- 1. Weigh the appropriate amount of wool on a precision balance.
- XPlease refer to the gas chromatograph instruction manual for the recommended amount of wool.
- 2. Hold the liner while wearing gloves to avoid skin contact with the glass.
- 3. Fill the liner with wool using tweezers.
- XThere is no need to push the entire amount of wool in.





- 4. Pack any wool that is protruding from the liner using the handle (thicker part) of the tools.
- 5. Adjust the position of the wool using the tool handle. The appropriate position depends on the instrument model. Refer to the gas chromatograph instruction manual for details. *Ensure the upper end of the wool is flat.

【Attention】 The appropriate position of the wool depends on the instrument model. Refer to the gas chromatograph instruction manual for details.



★For GC-2030/2050, fill the liner with wool so that the upper end of the wool is 22mm from the top end of the liner. Use a ruler to determine the correct position.

Procedure to remove wool

• Extract wool with the wire part of the wool removal tool.

*Care should be taken to avoid scratching the inner surface of the glass insert.
